### **Access to Childcare**

- **Holiday care provided across the Cluster**

- **Audit completed on current provision**

- **Provide CAF training for Staff**
- **Cluster Management Team to meet Area CAF Co-ordinator**
- **Governing bodies aware of CAF process and intended outcomes**
- **Evidence that all agencies work together**
- **Support the new North West/Rural Locality Structure**

### **Access to Community Provision**

- **Evaluate existing plans/SIP for 'improved access to community'**
- **Identify gaps and nominate priority areas for delivery**
- **Carry out a consultation exercise with the community**
- **Investigate different centres for the delivery of this provision**
- **Evaluate current marketing and communication channels**
- **Select appropriate marketing approaches for the Cluster**
